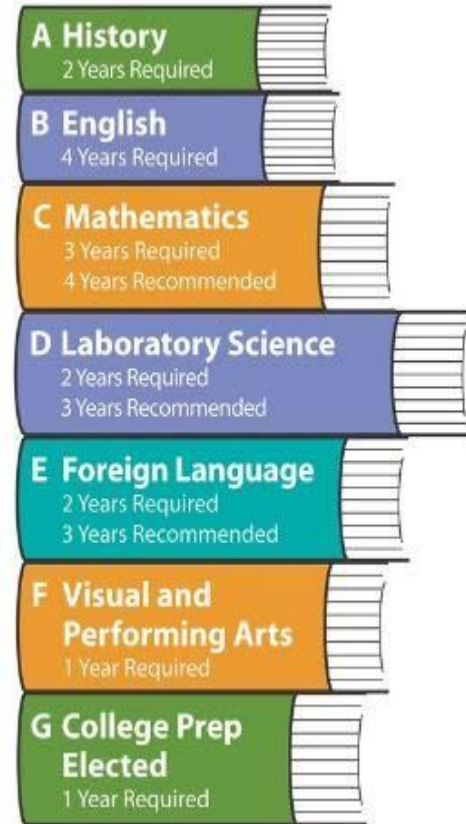


A-G Requirements

- A. History/Social Sciences (2 years required)
- B. English (4 years required)
- C. Math (3 years required, 4 years recommended)
- D. Lab Science (2 years required, 3-4 years recommended)
- E. Language (2 years required, 3-4 years recommended)
- F. Visual/Performing Arts (1 year required)
- G. College Prep Elective (1 year required)

Additional Requirements:

- Physical Education (2 years required)
- Health (One semester required)





Requisitos de Clases A-G

- A. Historia / Ciencias sociales (se requieren 2 años)
- B. Inglés (se requieren 4 años)
- C. Matemáticas (se requieren 3 años, se recomiendan 4 años)
- D. Laboratorio de Ciencias (se requieren 2 años, se recomiendan 3-4 años)
- E. Idioma (se requieren 2 años, se recomiendan 3-4 años)
- F. Artes visuales / escénicas (se requiere 1 año)
- G. Electiva de preparación universitaria (se requiere 1 año)

Requerimientos adicionales:

- Educación Física (se requieren 2 años)
- Salud (se requiere un semestre)

Math.....	30 Credits/ 3 Years
Science.....	30 Credits/ 3 Years
Foreign Language.....	20 Credits/ 2 Years
Visual & Performing Arts.....	10 Credits/ 1 Year
College Prep Elective.....	10 Credits/ 1 Year
Physical Education.....	20 Credits/ 2 Years
Health.....	5 Credits/ .5 Years
Electives.....	45 Credits/ 4.5 Years

Credit Recovery



- If students have failed a class it is important that they attend summer school right away to make up the class so they are not credit deficient.
- Summer school is typically 4 weeks in the summer and is in session Monday- Thursday from 8:30am-12:30pm.
- Freshmen- **60 credits**
- Sophomores- **120 credits**
- Juniors- **180 credits**
- Seniors- **230 credits**



Testing

Upcoming Test:

IABs- March 6th-10th

- Benchmark assessment that calculates how a student is prepared for standardized test.

NWEA- April 10th-14th

- Provides projections on how students may do on a standardized test focusing on Math and ELA

SBAC Testing (11th Grade Only)- May 8th -19th

- Important test that colleges and universities look at to help with admissions.

-AP English Language and Composition- Tuesday, May 9, 2023 @ 8am

-AP Spanish Language and Culture- Wednesday, May 10, 2023 @8am



SAT



What is the SAT?

The SAT is a three-hour multiple-choice test created and administered by the College Board. It covers reading, writing, and math, and is used to determine students' preparedness for college.

May 6th

June 3rd

- Get familiar with the PSAT/*Familiarizado con el PSAT*
- Look for summer opportunities (internships, volunteer work) / *Busque oportunidades de verano (pasantías, trabajo voluntario)*
- Start thinking about life after high school (explore interest, start setting goals)/*Comienza a pensar en la vida después de la escuela secundaria (explore el interés, comience a establecer metas)*
- Explore college and career interest/*Explora la universidad y el interés profesional*
